- **Directions from Whittier Farm to Keown Orchards:** Turn left on Douglas Rd. to Central Tpke and turn right. Follow Central Tpke to Dodge Hill Rd. and turn left. Turn right onto McClellan Rd.
- **Directions from Keown Orchards to Foppema's Farm:** Follow McClellan Rd. back to Dodge Hill Rd. where you will turn left and then turn left on Central Tpke. At Hill St. turn right. Foppema's Farm will be on your right.
- **Directions from Foppema's Farm to Bangma's Farm:** Turn right onto Hill St. and follow to Linwood Ave. where you will bear left to N. Main St. (Route 122) where you will bear right. Turn right onto Hartford Ave. W and follow to Bangma's Farm which will be on your left.
- **Directions from Bangma's Farm to Whittier Farms:** Turn left on Hartford Ave. W which changes to NE Main St. Follow to West St. where you will bear right. Continue to NW Main St. and turn right. NW Main St. changes to Douglas Rd. Whittier Farms will be on your left.
