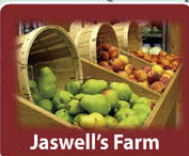

FARM STANDS OF THE VALLEY - 2

Unique among the historic buildings, beautiful scenery, and quaint villages of the Blackstone Valley are its farm stands. Enjoy the fresh produce, home made goodies, and lots of family fun activities.

Begin your day at the **Blackstone Valley Visitor Center** in Pawtucket, Rhode Island. Travel to **Phantom Farms** where you will be greeted by a friendly staff and the aroma from the bakery. Voted one of "Rhode Island's Best" farm stands, gift baskets here are a specialty item.

Next is **Vadenais Farm** where it's one stop shopping. Browse the baskets, crafts, pantry items or shop for dinner while the kids enjoy the petting zoo. Friday and Saturday nights in October, a haunted corn maze from 7-10pm welcomes the Halloween ghosts.

Dairy products don't get any fresher than those at **Wrights Dairy Farm & Bakery**. Wrights offers a full service bakery, entertaining cow facts, and milkings daily from 3:30pm to 5pm.

Travel on to **Smith's Farm**, a great place for apple picking. Shop for delicious pies and fall specialties for your Thanksgiving fixings.

Move on to **Harmony Farms** where in early July you can pick your own blueberries, Mon-Thu, 8am-12pm and 6pm-8pm; Fri, 8am-12pm; Sat & Sun, 8am-4pm. Don't miss the honey, peaches, or raspberries. In September and October, apple picking is Tue-Sun, 9am-5pm.

Jaswell's Farm has received both RI's "Best Stop on a Fall Outing" and "Best Farm Stand" awards. This stand doesn't miss a season. It offers fresh produce and plants, a bakery, pasteurized cider, gourmet apples and Christmas trees.

- Blackstone Valley Visitor Center to Phantom Farms: Turn left onto Roosevelt Ave., continue to Exchange St., turn left and follow to Broad St. (Route 114). Turn right onto Broad St. and continue to Dexter St. (Route 123) in Cumberland where you will turn right. Then turn left onto High St. (Route 114) which becomes Diamond Hill Rd. From the intersection of Route 295, continue 1.7 more miles. Phantom Farms will be on your left.
- Phantom Farm to Vadenais Farm: Turn left onto Diamond Hill Rd. and follow to Pine Swamp Rd. Turn left and continue to Vadenais Farm which will be on your left.
- Vadenais Farm to Wrights Farm: Turn right then right again onto W. Wrentham Rd. At Mendon Rd. (Route 122) turn left then right onto Manville Hill Rd. Follow to a right on Railroad Ave., a left onto Summer St. and right onto Sayles Hill Rd. At Route 145 turn right and follow to 146A. Bear right and continue to Woonsocket Hill Rd. where you will turn left. Wrights Dairy Farm will be on your left.
- Wrights Farm to Smith's Farm: Turn left on Route 146A and continue to Route 102 (Victory Hwy) where you will bear left and continue to Burrillville where it becomes Bronco Hwy. After Farm Rd., Smith's Farm will be on your right.
- Smith's Farm to Harmony Farms: Turn right onto Route 102. Bear left at the Route 100 intersection. (Routes 102 and 44 run concurrently here.) Pass through the town of Chepachet and turn left onto Route 44 (Putnam Pike). Follow Putnam Pike to Sawmill Hill Rd. where you will turn right. Harmony Farms will be on your right after Snake Hill Rd.
- Harmony Farms to Jaswell's Farms: Turn left onto Sawmill Hill Rd. and return to Route 44 where you will turn right. Continue to Pleasant Hill Rd. and turn left. Follow to Swan Rd. Turn left. Jaswell's will be on your left.

Jaswell's Farms to the Visitor Center: Return to Pleasant View Rd. and turn right then bear left onto Cedar Swamp Rd. At Route 44 turn left and proceed to Route 15 (Mineral Spring Ave.). Follow Route 15 into Pawtucket. Mineral Spring becomes Church St. Turn left on Park Place East and follow to Main St. where you will turn right. Turn left on Roosevelt Ave.
